

ASI Parts System FTP Download Instructions

FTP Download instructions for ASI Parts System

Note: Call ASI (800-826-5045) for download password before starting this update.

This update applies ONLY to ASI software that was installed using the default installation folders. If you have a non-default installation you can change extract destination folders when executing updates to the location database and parts folders are located on your computer.

You may also call ASI and request a DVD update.

Windows Explorer (Not Internet Explorer)

In Windows Explorer address bar type:

<ftp://asirvparts.zftp.com> (press enter)

Login box appears. (use lower case)

Username = asidownload1@asirvparts.zftp.com

Password = Call for password (password valid for 24 hours).

When FTP window opens look for "ASIupdate" folder.

Right click once on "ASIupdate" folder

Left click Copy to Folder

Left Click My documents(or wherever you want to download it to).

When finished copying (download time depends on your download speed... This file is about 70 MB compressed and may take 5-15 minutes)

Close FTP connection (click X in right hand corner, or File, Exit.)

Go to My documents (or wherever you downloaded file)

Find "ASIupdate" folder . Double click to open.

This folder contains 2 zip files [ASIdb.exe](#) and [ASIpics.exe](#)

(Note: Win 98SE systems may require manual file extraction- call ASI for help)

Double click [ASIdb.exe](#)

Click Unzip (extracts to C:\Program Files\Asiparts by default.)

Click Close when finished. Do same procedure for ASIpics.exe.

If Windows asks you to overwrite existing files, answer “yes to all”.

Note: If you are using ASI Parts as a standalone program on several machines, this update must be applied to each system. Copy the ASIupdate folder (ASIdb.exe and ASIpics.exe) to each system and run. Location of these files does not matter. Update files will automatically extract to system folders.

**Start ASI Parts System.
Enter Login ID if asked.
Update is complete.**

**If you are using ASI Parts in a Server/Client application,
apply update to server only.**
